Trousse d'évaluation pour le classement des apprenants adultes

Centre FORA often receives questions about the *Trousse d'évaluation pour le classement des apprenants adultes*.

Questions and answers

1. What is the purpose of the Trousse d'évaluation pour le classement des apprenants adultes?

The primary purpose of this evaluation toolkit is to provide a fair picture of learners' literacy skills before they start learning. The items in each test match the level of difficulty found in the PILA module sequence. The 7 tests help practitioners to determine where the learner should start learning in the PILA modules (PILA is French-language adult reading intervention program).

2. Why a revised version of the evaluation toolkit?

The revised version reflects the changes suggested by the centres that took part in the toolkit validation. The toolkit was also validated by its author, Mr. Alain Desrochers.

3. Do we need a toolkit for each learner?

Only one evaluation toolkit is required for your centre as long as there is only one practitioner using it at a time. The evaluation is done individually rather than with a group.

4. Are we allowed to copy the toolkit?

The following sections of the kit can be reproduced as required:

- Activité d'écriture : Dictée de mots
- Cahier de notation : Dossier de l'apprenant

5. What is the format of the toolkit?



The examiner's guide describes:

- The evaluative approach
- The interpretation of scores
